



## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

### Academic Year 2026-2027

The PRMSDC Scholarship is open to undergraduate students in Puerto Rico who demonstrate academic merit and financial need. Scholarships are awarded based on available program funds.

**Priority will be given to students whose parents or legal guardians work for PRMSDC-certified companies or corporate members.** However, **all eligible students are welcome to apply, even if their parents are not affiliated with PRMSDC organizations.**

**⚠️ Please note:** Students whose parents or legal guardians **own or serve as president, CEO, or founder** of a certified minority business are **not eligible** for this scholarship.

Any false information provided may lead to disqualification.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING OUT THE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM:

- Fill in the application form electronically. (Handwritten applications will not be accepted.)
- Read the application form carefully.
- Submit a duly completed application form with required supporting documents to [scholarshipfund@prmsdc.org](mailto:scholarshipfund@prmsdc.org) by October 30, 2026. Ensure you have attached all the documents needed by putting a tick mark on the checklist.
- Incomplete applications may be rejected. Please answer all the questions.



## Application Form Check List

### Requirements

- ✓ Scholarships are open only to students attending college (**Academic year 2026-2027**) in Puerto Rico.
- ✓ Scholarship priority will be given to students whose parents or legal guardians work for a PRMSDC Certified MBE or a Member associate who must be active as of December 15, 2026. If not, if enough students apply for the Scholarship from our pool of MBEs/Members and/or funds remain available, other applying students who meet the criteria may be considered for scholarship recipients.
- ✓ Full-time undergraduate (**second to fifth year**) college students (public or private) with at least 12 credits. Students must major in **business administration or STEM programs**. (See Appendix A)
- ✓ The student must provide evidence of FAFSA Student Aid. Priority will be given to students with a FAFSA Student Aid index of -1,500 to 0.
- ✓ Students must be claimed as a dependent on the parent's or legal guardian's tax return.
- ✓ Students must have a 3.0 grade-point average (or equivalent).
- ✓ Open only for students between 18 and 22 years, as of December 15, 2026.
- ✓ Students must be U.S. Citizens.

### Documents

- ✓ Scholarship Application Form.
- ✓ Proof of college registration for the 2026 Fall Academic Semester. Government-issued ID (Student, Parent, or legal tutor).
- ✓ Student's Birth Certificate or any other government-issued document proving age and citizenship.
- ✓ A minimum of 350-word Motivation Essay in which you explain why you are applying for the Scholarship and how it will help you achieve your goals. **The use of AI (Artificial Intelligence) is not permitted**. The essay could be in Spanish or English.
- ✓ College Grades Transcript (Does not have to be an official transcript).
- ✓ If applicable, a letter from the MBE certifying the employment of the parent or legal tutor.
- ✓ If applicable, students with legal tutors must provide court documents that support their status.
